Every gift, large or small, has already made a tangible difference: two fully assembled buildings now stand on our site, forming the foundation of the hospital we are building together. We are deeply grateful to everyone who has contributed so far.

Project Overview

This project will bring an ambulatory surgery center to a community that currently has limited access to safe, timely surgical care. The site sits on cleared agricultural land in a rural highland setting, with room to grow into a full campus over time.

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Progress to Date: Two Buildings on the Ground

Our organization has purchased two prefabricated buildings from a company in Australia. Both units were shipped to the site, assembled on location by our team and local crew, and are now standing complete. These two structures form the founding footprint of the hospital campus — the first physical step toward the surgery center.

Behind the Scenes

Getting two full buildings assembled on a rural site is no small task. Materials, tools, and a support container had to be brought in and staged before assembly could begin, and each unit required careful interior fit-out once the shell was in place.

Our Long-Term Vision



Ambulatory Surgical Center Plans

The two buildings now standing are only the beginning. Over the next five years, our plan is to expand this foundation into a complete ambulatory surgery center by adding:

- Additional prefabricated units, following the same model as the two buildings already completed, to expand capacity for staff, storage, and patient services.
- A dedicated operating room, purpose-built to support safe surgical procedures for the community.
- A recovery area, where patients can rest and be monitored under proper care following surgery.

Each phase builds directly on the foundation your support has already helped us lay. As we add units and construct the operating room and recovery area, this site will grow from two standalone buildings into a functioning surgical facility serving patients who currently have few, if any, safe local options for surgical care.

Estimated Investment

We estimate the total cost to complete this project — from the two buildings already in place through the operating room, recovery area, and any additional units — at approximately \$200,000 over the next five years. This figure covers construction, materials, site work, and fit-out for the remaining phases of the project.

We recognize this is a significant goal, and we do not expect to reach it alone. Every contribution, whether it funds a portion of a future building, equipment for the operating room, or general project costs, moves us measurably closer to opening this center to the community that needs it.
